TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT

RESERVATIONS AND ENROLLMENT:

When we receive your signed application and deposit of \$250, we will confirm your reservation and enrollment. Reservations are accepted in the order in which they are received. Spaces are limited and based on session and grade group.

TUITION, DEPOSIT AND TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Tuition includes: Board and lodging, infirmary, instruction, guidance, training, complete camp program, \$50 store credit and transportation from and to St. Louis. Tuition also includes your \$250 reservation deposit, with the balance due on or before May 1st, 2012.

SIBLING DISCOUNT:

For each additional child from the same family enrolled for the summer of 2012, there is a discount of \$100.

INCLUDED STORE CREDIT:

Included in the tuition is a \$50 store credit to help cover personal expenses during the session such as laundry, toilet articles, postal's, T-shirts, sweat shirts, shorts, pants, hats, field trips and store items etc. There will be NO REFUNDS issued for this money. Any balance spent over \$50 will be billed to you in an itemized statement at the end of the session.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided from and to St. Louis by air conditioned highway coach. Our buses leave from the Laumeier Office Park parking lot at Geyer & Watson by I-44.

RISKS INVOLVED IN CAMPING ACTIVITIES:

The parents acknowledge that participating in outdoor and adventure activities in a camp setting includes inherent and other risks, hazards and dangers that cannot necessarily be predicted or controlled. In March you will receive a packet of forms containing important information associated with your child's camp experience. Please read and complete these forms carefully. All forms must be completed and signed by parents and the camper, as appropriate. Final acceptance to the camp session is contingent upon our receipt and review of all forms.

THE CAMP COMMUNITY:

Each child must be able to live successfully in an active social community that includes constant interaction with other children. Camp Taum Sauk reserves the right to refuse admission or to send home without refund any camper who presents a safety concern, medical risk or whose behavior is deemed disruptive or harmful to the best interests of other campers or to the camp community. Both the parent(s) and their participating children understand they must follow all camp rules. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, narcotics, recreational drugs, knives, fireworks and firearms are not permitted.

CANCELLATION:

The \$250 deposit will be fully refunded for cancellations received by April 1st. No portion of the deposit will be refunded for cancellations received after April 1st. For cancellations received after June 1st, no refunds of deposit or tuition will be made. In the event of absence from the camp due to illness, natural disaster, act of war or terrorism, or for any other reason, financial loss will be shared equally between the camp and the parents. Parents are responsible for all costs of early departure for any reason.

PHOTO RELEASE:

Camp Taum Sauk representatives will be photographing and videotaping campers and activities during each camp session for promotional purposes. I authorize Camp Taum Sauk to use my or my child's photo or video recording for advertising, display or other use for Camp Taum Sauk and the American Camping Association.
